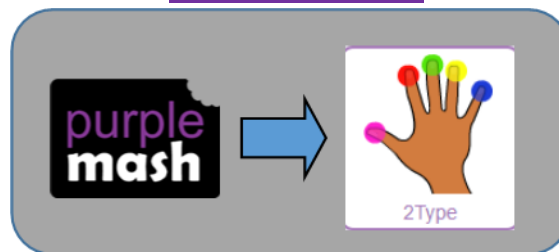

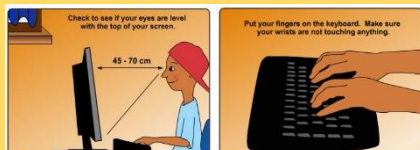


Key Vocabulary

- Posture** – The correct way to sit at the computer.

- Space bar** – The bar at the bottom of the keyboard.
